

VILLAGE BURIAL FOR AIR VICTIM

THE BODY of the 29-year-old co-pilot of the British Airways Trident, killed in a mid-air collision over Yugoslavia, will be buried at Middleton Tyas on Monday.

As a boy, Brian Edward Helm, of Aldershot, often came to Middleton Tyas to stay with his grandparents, Mr and Mrs Thomas Helm.

He had expressed a wish to

be buried there. His grandparents are now dead and are buried at the Parish Church but his uncle, Mr Frank Helm, a joiner, still lives in the village.

Mr Helm leaves a wife and two children.

There were no survivors of the air crash in which 176 died on September 10.
