Our role during the pandemic is very much to conduct patrols in our communities, to provide some reassurance and offer advice and to educate and encourage residents to adhere to government guidance. We are also conducting patrols in our districts beauty spots, this is to make sure that we are not getting visitors travelling long distances putting themselves or our rural communities at further risk.

Due to the closure of our local waste and recycling facilities there has been an increase in reported cases of fly tipping. This has resulted in several joint investigations with North Yorkshire Police and Richmondshire District Council whereby a number of fixed penalty notices have been issued.
